- 5 Close the boxes and assemble onto a pallet.
- 6 Once the pallet is full, email our recycling partner [kimtechsolutions@terracycle.com](mailto:kimtechsolutions@terracycle.com) to arrange pick-up and return shipment.

- Use your own collection boxes and pallet.

*Pallet should be standard size (48" x 40") with a maximum height of 96" (maximum weight - 1,000 lbs.).*

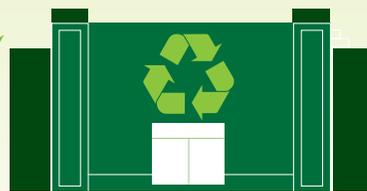
Product is worn in your facility
