



# MOSS

## TIPS:

- Upon initial planting, mist several times each week for 2-3 weeks to ensure the moss does not dry out.
- Avoid excessive light and heat especially for the first 2-3 weeks.
- Moss can be secured around a damp mat or ball of sphagnum to help it adjust to the new habitat faster and prevent drying out.

## TO GET STARTED:

- Prepare the substrate by digging a small two inch hole to accommodate the plant
- Remove the plant from the pot being careful to not damage the roots
- Gently remove as much substrate from the plant and discard in the substrate in the trash
- Lightly rinse the plant under de-chlorinated room temperature, or distilled water
- Place the plant in the hole in the substrate
- Fill in the open areas in the hole with substrate until the it covers just up to the base of the plant
- Gently smooth out the substrate
- Water according to care directions below, always using room temperature water
